Urge State Senator, Jim Beall, to Support Title IX Compliance!

We all know the statistics and have heard the stories. **Research** has shown that sexual violence in schools is all too prevalent. Yet, **89 percent of colleges and universities** reported ZERO incidences of rape on campus and **67 percent of local education agencies** reported NO instances of sexual harassment or gender-based bullying in the last federally-required data collection. Unfortunately, these numbers don't reflect the reality for women on campus and in schools. While zero incidences of sexual harassment would be something to celebrate, what is more likely is that schools do not have processes in place to protect against and accurately report harassment.

That's why it's crucial our legislature enact Senate Bill 169 to help remedy this under-reporting of sexual harassment and assaults and to assist schools in supporting their students.

California has consistently developed new laws to protect against sexual assault and harassment, on and off campus. But those laws need to be enforced in a manner that gives survivors confidence that their grievances are being treated fairly.

SB 169 provides the guidance that many schools need to create programs that will be proactive in preventing these crimes, and take fair and immediate action once matters have been brought to their attention.

Schools need to provide equal educational opportunities for all students. Ask Senator Jim Beall to support Title IX compliance by voting "AYE" on SB 169.
