The History of Women's Suffrage

After a hard-fought series of votes in the U.S. Congress and in state legislatures, the **Nineteenth Amendment** became part of the U.S. Constitution on August 18, 1920. To mark this year's centennial of Women's Suffrage, Bonnie J. Morris, PhD, will offer a lively history of the arguments FOR and AGAINST women's suffrage, taking us back to 19th century attitudes toward women in politics and public life.



Dr. Morris is currently a lecturer at UC Berkeley and the author of sixteen books, including *Women's History for Beginners* which was broadcast on C-Span. Her book *The Feminist Revolution* was selected by Oprah magazine as top reading for Women's History Month. She has taught women's history for over 25 years at various universities and has been a guest lecturer for the Library of Congress and the State Department.

The Woman Who Originally Discovered Coronavirus

Scientific pioneer **June Almeida** is finally being acknowledged for virology breakthroughs she made a half-century ago. June's work has come roaring back into focus during the present pandemic. COVID-19 is a new illness but it is caused by a coronavirus of the type first identified by Dr. Almeida in 1964 at her laboratory in St Thomas's Hospital in London. At the time she gained a reputation for extending the range of the electron microscope to new limits. June Almeida died in 2007, at the age of 77. Now 13 years after her death she is finally getting the recognition she deserves as a pioneer whose work speeded up an understanding of the virus that is currently spreading throughout the world.

Perhaps a woman will discover a cure for COVID-19!
