A Message from the Co-Presidents

The recent events focusing on the death of George Floyd have given many of us pause to reflect on our communities, our institutions and ourselves. This was not the first time that a black man died at the hands of police. But it is the first time that the protesters have continued to protest throughout the weeks, not just in our country but around the world. People seem to sense that this time real change will happen.



The California AAUW Board issued a statement that "AAUW is committed to fighting for justice and will work collaboratively to give access for all people to the opportunities and resources needed for optimal health and safety. Our organization is a member of the Leadership Conference on Civil and Human Rights." These words are not merely words but have power if we truly believe them.

California AAUW sponsored a panel discussion on diversity and offered ideas to help promote diversity within AAUW. One suggestion, among many, is to collaborate with other groups that have similar goals. We need to broaden our lives to include people who "don't look like us" in our programs and community activities. We should look at the statistics on housing, education, and health care in our communities and see how we can make changes to improve equity and diversity. Perhaps we can celebrate International Day for Women next March 8, 2021 or explore other opportunities to broaden our outreach to the wider community around us.

Help Get Out the Vote

A successful democracy depends on the electorate participating at the polls! VOTING has never been as crucial as it will be this November, during unprecedented, uncertain and precarious times here in the US. An encouraging letter has proven successful in increasing voter turnout.

Member Carol Fitting suggests signing up at web site www.votefwd.org to send letters to traditionally under-served registered voters, in eight key states, who are unlikely to move soon and unlikely to vote; this known from long years of record keeping. Senders are unidentifiable; a template for non-partisan letters is provided, with the sender filling in a short personal message. First class postage, paper, envelopes and time are all that's required of volunteers. It's a simple way to help! The web site is easy to use and self-explanatory.
