Oct. 6, 2023–THE CROSSROADS OF THE MEDITERRANEAN presented by World Traveler Virginia Turner.

"Explore the tiny island of Malta with AAUW member Virginia Turner and her husband Drew Sullivan. Malta is located strategically almost exactly in the middle of the Mediterranean Sea, both east/west and north/south. Its rich history goes back more than 6,000 years: megalithic temples which are older than the Pyramids of Egypt, spectacular cathedrals which trace their roots to the apostle Paul who was shipwrecked on his way to Rome, mansions of the Crusaders and the Knights of St. John who sent a "Maltese Falcon" to their French lords every year, underground rooms which track its heroic role in World War II for which the country was awarded the George Cross. Independent modern Malta brings together various cultures and peoples from the entire Mediterranean area."

Nov. 3, 2023 – SAFARI TO INCREDIBLE BOTSWANA presented by photographer Mercury Freedom.

"We experienced the first days of our trip in a double-decker houseboat on the Chobe River where we went out each morning and evening in small boats to see and photograph the many animals that inhabit the land around the Chobe River. The photography was great and the food very good as it was during all of the trip. Moving on, we visited the Okavango Delta staying in tent platforms where we were served coffee at 5:00 am each morning to prepare us for our 6:00 am trip out in land rovers to visit the wild life. The second trip of the day always ended at twilight or dark, enabling us to see and photograph as much as possible. Our last stop was in the Kalahari Desert where we were again in tent platforms and would hunt for wild life each day in land rovers ,sometimes visiting water holes to see and photograph less seen animals there. To end this great trip, we spent two free days visiting Victoria Falls and the surrounding areas in Zimbabwe!"

Jan. 5, 2024 - VIETNAM AND CAMBODIA-A "BUCKET LIST" ADVENTURE presented by traveler Robert Torczyner.

"From the narrow winding streets of Lisbon to the bustling medinas of Marrakech, this will be a captivating photo presentation offering a glimpse into the charm of history and modernity found in Portugal and Morocco. Join us as we explore Lisbon, the Douro Valley where the delicious Port wine is made, the volcanic Azore Islands 1,200 miles west of Portugal, and on to Morocco and Casablanca, Marrakech and the blue city o f Chefchaouen."

"After years of isolation due to Covid, tourism to Japan is alive again. But with the language barrier, independent travel there has always been daunting. We crafted a circular self-directed tour of the main island of Honshu (Dragonfly Island) using a range of interesting lodging options and non-reserved rail transfers. Careful planning resulted in a fascinating dive into the rich cultural, historical and religious experiences of this ancient island. The trip included the cities of Osaka, Koyasan, Okayama, Hisoshima, Kyoto, Takayama, Kanazawa, Toyko and more. The well-designed transportation and accommodations, interesting foods, reverent temples, and, most important, the well structured and polite social order combined to afford us a remarkable travel experience."\\
